

RESOLUTIONS OF THE FABSR MEETING, TULCEA, 16 October 2010

In their meeting in Tulcea on 16 October 2010, the FABSR members have agreed upon the following resolutions:

- The FABSR Term Presidency of the Order of Architects of Romania (OAR) will be extended until October 2011;
- The Union of Architects of Bulgaria (UAB) will take over the FABSR Term Presidency from Romania during a FABSR event to be hosted by UAB in Bulgaria by October 2011;
- Tulcea Declaration, adopted in this meeting and attached to these resolutions, shall be disseminated to all relevant circles in the Black Sea;
- FABSR will continue its contacts with countries in the Black Sea basin, which are not yet its members, and in this framework will invite the Union of Architects of Moldova to join FABSR in the next meeting;
- FABSR meetings need more contribution and participation from its members and, therefore, those FABSR members which have not participated in the last two meetings are called to communicate to the FABSR Term Presidency or Secretariat their reasons or problems for non-participation, so that, in the future meetings, it will be possible to find a solution to organize widely participated FABSR meetings;
- FABSR members will work in collaboration to develop an Architectural Policy for the Black Sea and the Order of Architects of Romania (OAR) will lead an architectural ideas competition for gathering ideas for such a policy;
- As the regional organizations of architects in Region II will participate in the UIA Council meetings on a rotating manner and as FABSR is invited to participate in the UIA Council Meeting in June 2011 in Singapore, it is decided that UIA Council Member Deniz Incedayi will also represent FABSR in this meeting.
